NHA has been actively promoting ABDM enablement of HMIS operating in the ecosystem. The list of such HMIS can be accessed at <https://abdm.gov.in/our-partners/HMIS>. For smaller health facilities, NHA in collaboration with C-DAC has developed a government-supported HMIS, namely e-Sushrut@Clinic which is a plug-and-play solution.

All concerned Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) are requested to use e-Sushrut@Clinic and Hospital Management Information System (HMIS) and integrate it with Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) to create a seamless digital health experience for citizens.

As you may be aware, the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) is being implemented by National Health Authority to create the digital public infrastructure for health in the country. In this regard, I am writing to seek your support in promoting the use of ABDM enabled digital solutions across health facilities functioning under your administrative control.

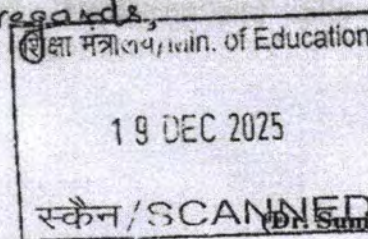
2. Adoption of ABDM-enabled solutions will allow facilities to use ABHA for patients to create their longitudinal health history, securely connect with stakeholders across the healthcare ecosystem, and promote interoperability of health records. Therefore, it is important that all public facilities, including smaller facilities, begin using ABDM enabled solutions to create a seamless digital health experience for citizens.

3. NHA has been actively promoting ABDM enablement for Hospital Management Information System (HMIS) operating in the ecosystem. The list of such HMIS can be accessed here: <https://abdm.gov.in/our-partners/HMIS>. For smaller health facilities, NHA in collaboration with C-DAC has developed a government-supported HMIS, namely, e-Sushrut@Clinic. It is plug and play solution and facilities may register and begin using the platform at: <https://ehmis-lite.in>. Further, vide D.O. No. S-12012/151/2022-ABDM(Coord) dated 5 April 2023, it was requested that all public health facilities should generate and share digital health records using ABDM-compliant solutions.

5. In view of the above, it is requested that small facilities under your department may be advised to use e-Sushrut@Clinic. For the other larger facilities, they may be directed to use ABDM enabled HMIS only. And if the facilities already use an HMIS, it can be integrated with ABDM. Additionally, it is requested that a nodal person may be appointed from your end to facilitate the interaction with the health facilities under your administrative control.

6. NHA will extend all necessary support to the facilities intending to use ABDM enabled HMIS. Your support in ensuring adoption of ABDM-enabled HMIS across all health facilities will greatly strengthen our collective efforts toward building a robust digital health ecosystem.
