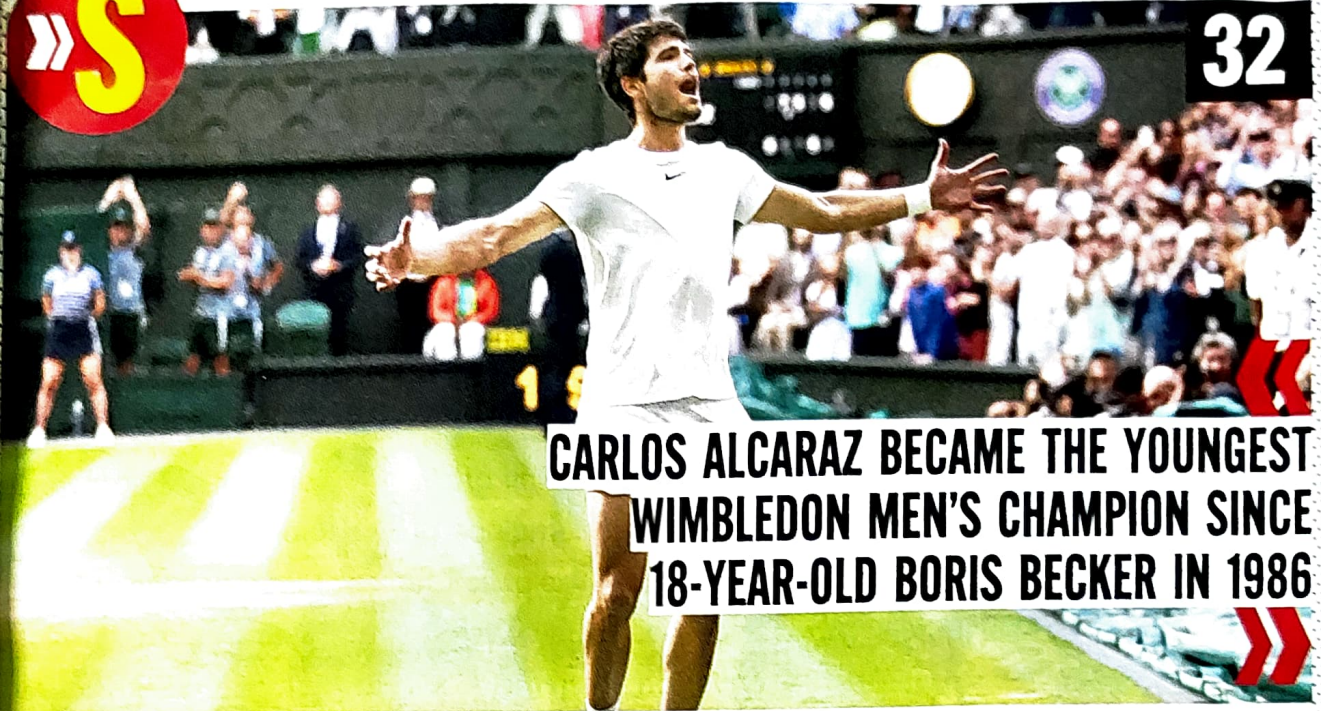

For Galip Kurdi

Alan Kurdi was three and his photograph ended the world. He lay face down and the blue red of his clothes was striking in its strange tidiness on the shore. Hours later the Turkish coast guards recuperated the bodies of his mother and small five-year-old brother, Galip, but of him there are no photographs.

No one can mimic his final image moored face down at the water's edge. No artist can provide that low blow. Ah, the world of art, the world of images, billions of images. The words of a poem are cleaner, more pure.

When the boat filled with Syrian immigrants overturned, the father swam from one boy to the other trying in desperation to save them, but he could only see how they disappeared. I wasn't there, I'm not his father.

There are no photographs of Galip Kurdi, he can't hear he can't see, he can't feel, and the silence comes down like immense white cloths.

Below the silence you can make out a piece of sea, of the sea of pain, I'm not his father but Galip Kurdi is my son.

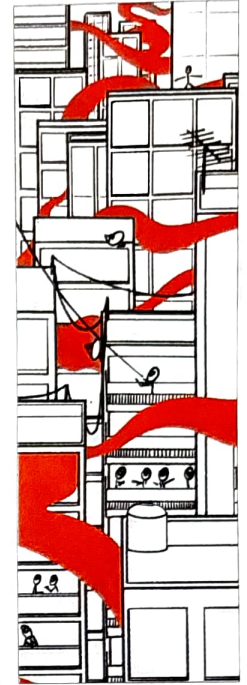


Academic and author Prof Ajay Gudavarthy is the guest editor of this issue. He has helped the Outlook editorial team put together articles and reports on the theme of Politics of Emotions—how emotions fill the scaffolding of politics. "There is a global resurgence of rightwing authoritarian regimes across the world; surely, the world hasn't become intolerant and toxic overnight. Beneath the visible illiberality seems to be a gnawing sense of emptiness and nothingness. We are into an 'age of emotions' where subjective experiences and expressions have exploded. It is to explore this underbelly of the everydayness that we began to plan a special issue of the Outlook magazine that had already positioned itself as an out-of-box thought experiment to gather human stories replete with emotions—some that we seem to understand and some we do not. All of us involved in the issue felt the need to bring raw human stories alongside those reflecting on the predicaments of the human condition. We attempted to foreground the other side of illiberality not just to critique or dismiss it with contempt, but to make a better sense of it with an understanding that mere rejection would only add to the toxicity that we seem to abhor.
